| Parks/Recreation | 2,661 | \$15,351,855.57 | 4% | 2% |

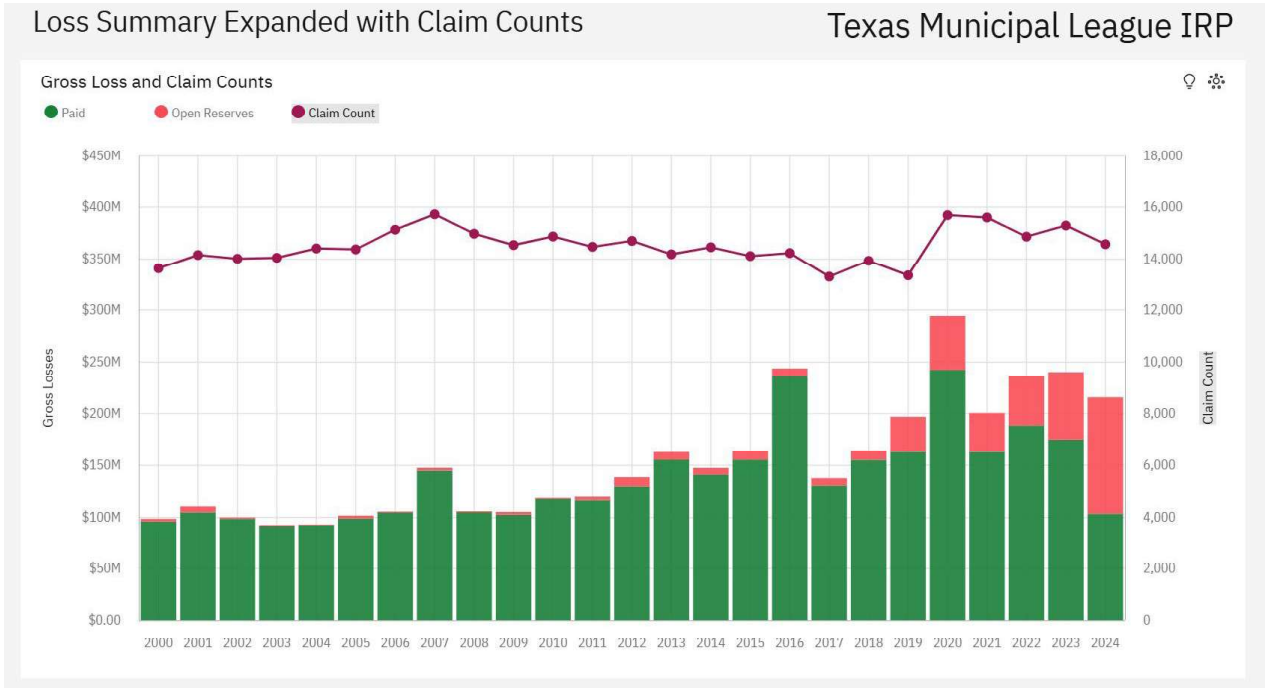
Building for the Future



1. Transition the Loss Prevention Department's Law Enforcement Training Specialist to Law Enforcement Outreach Consultant. Added a second Consultant position.
2. Continue to Support the Texas Police Chiefs Association's Officer Safety Committee.
3. Continue to develop risk management-focused training for law enforcement leaders.
4. Encourage law enforcement department accreditation through direct financial aid and/or underwriting.
5. Develop minimum policy recommendations for smaller departments.

Loss Summary Expanded with Claim Counts

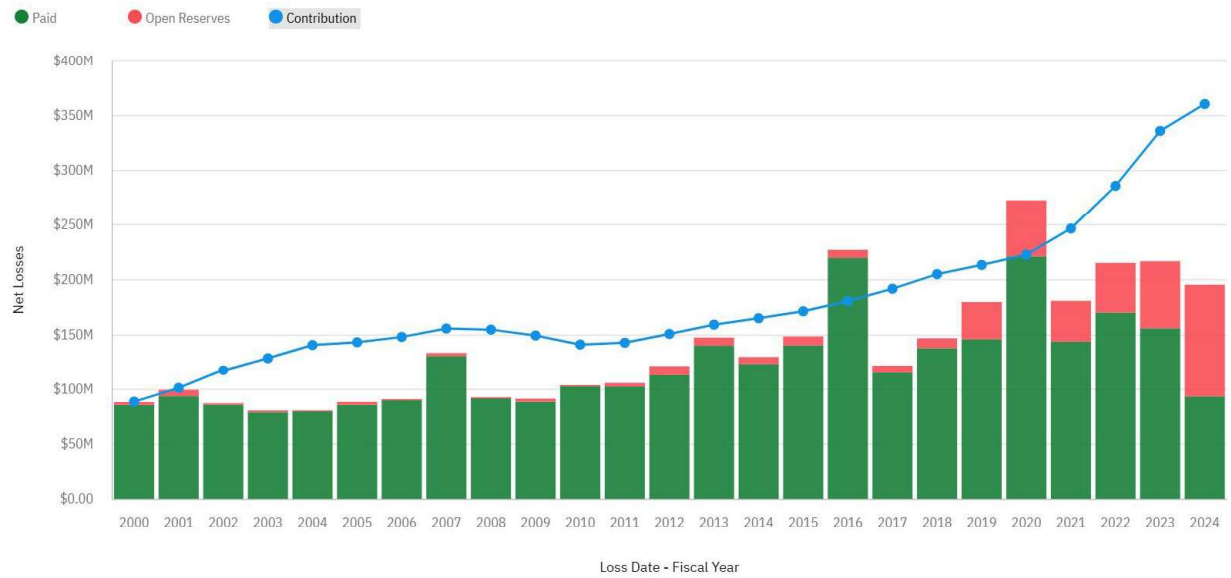
Texas Municipal League IRP

Net Loss and Contribution

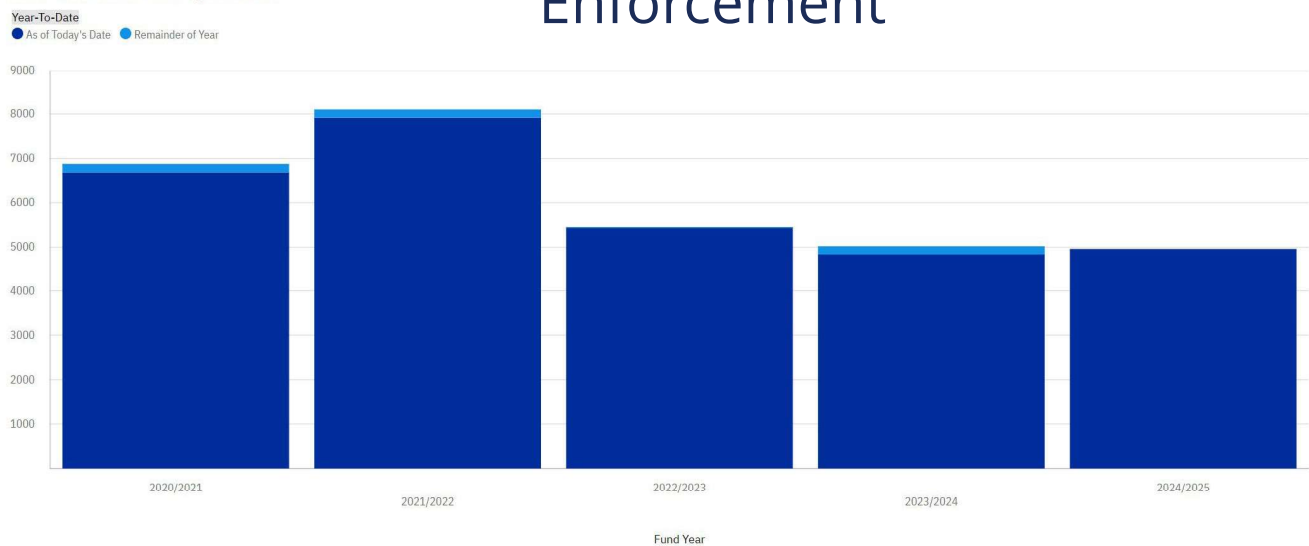

Claim Count Year-To-Date by Fund Year



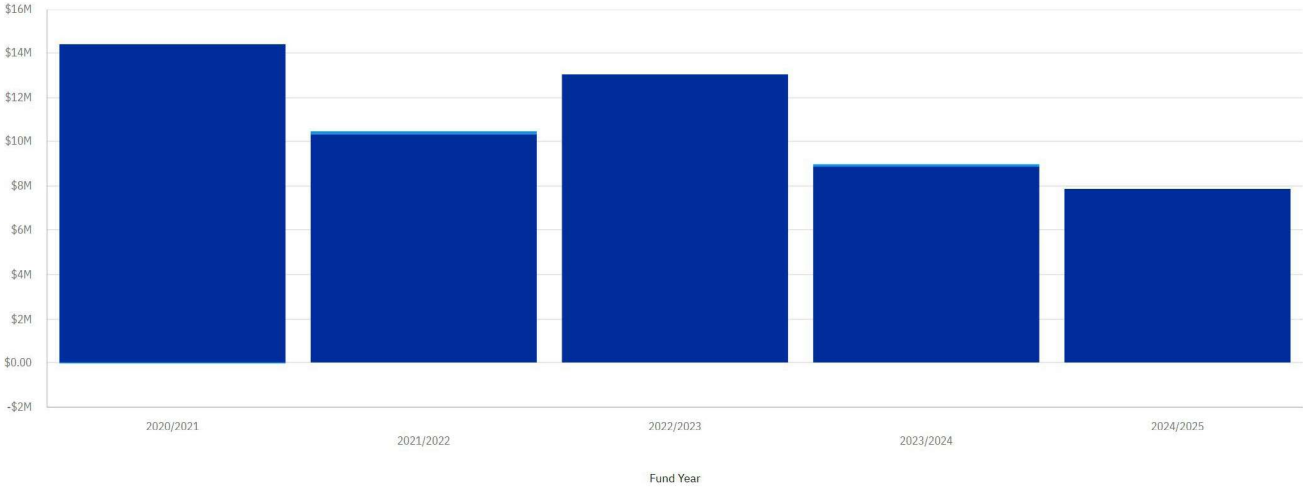

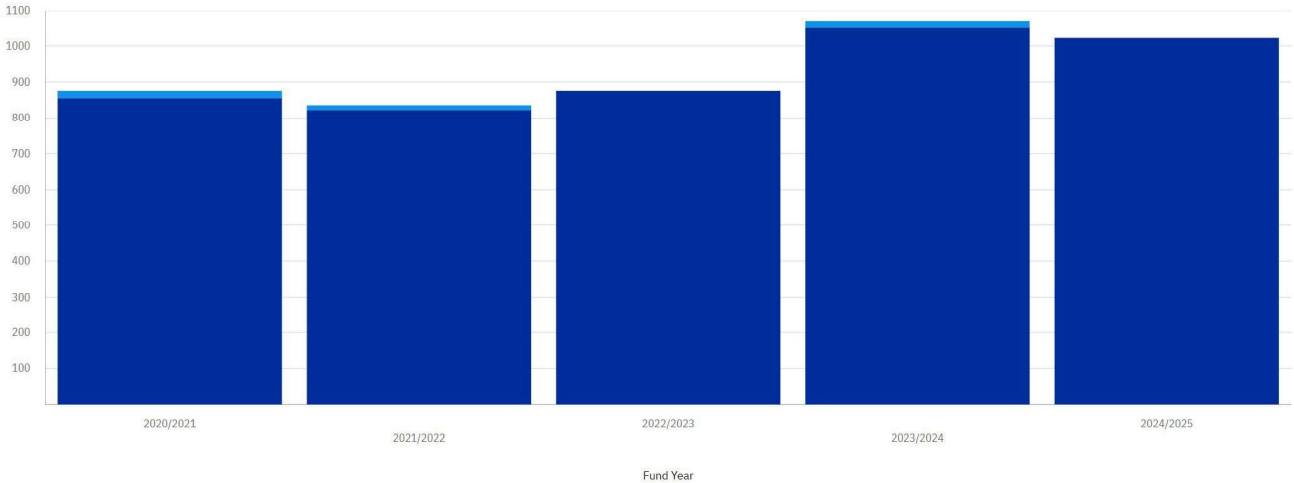

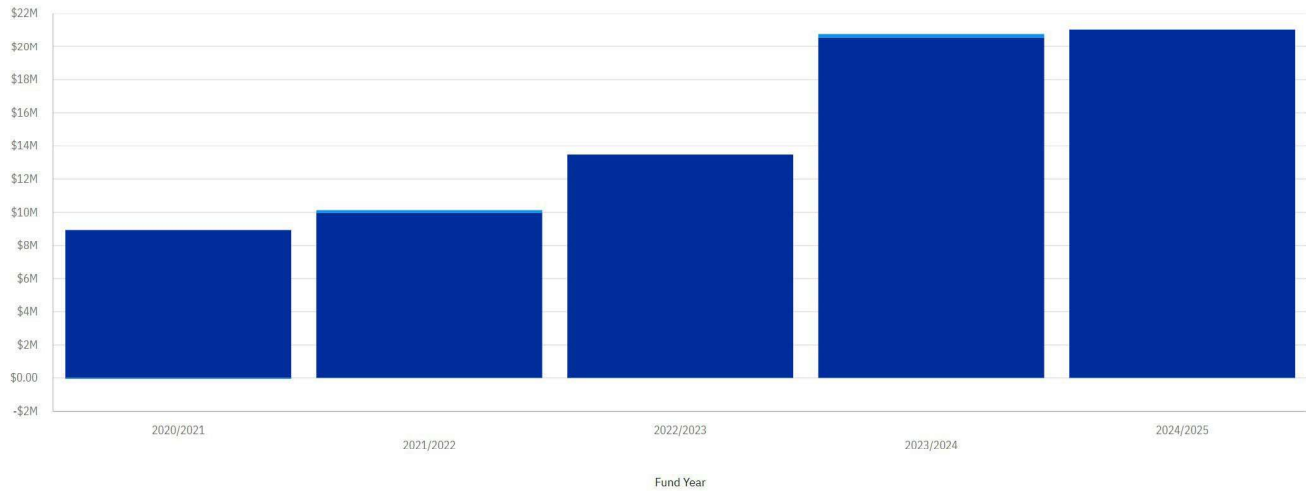


Auto Claims by Cost – Law Enforcement

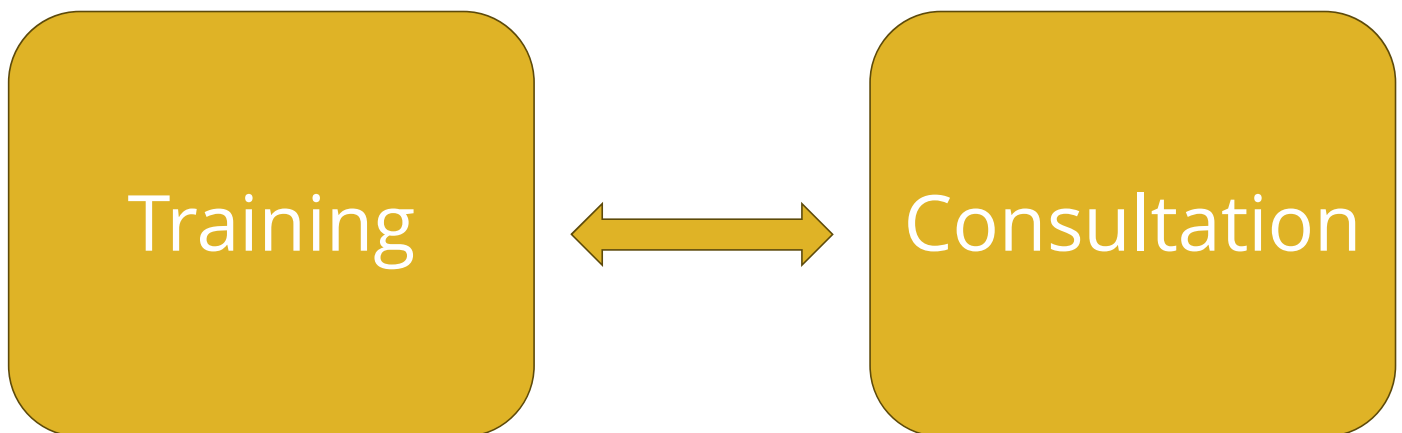
Year-To-Date Loss by Fund Year
